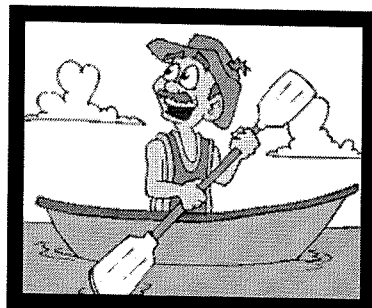

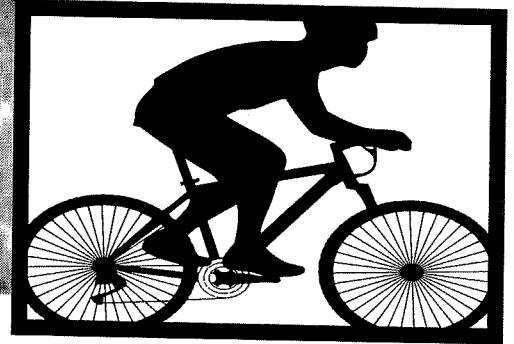
Speeding: Please watch your speed. 9.5 mph is the limit. Keep your foot on the brake. Also, DO NOT get confrontational with anyone. Thank you!

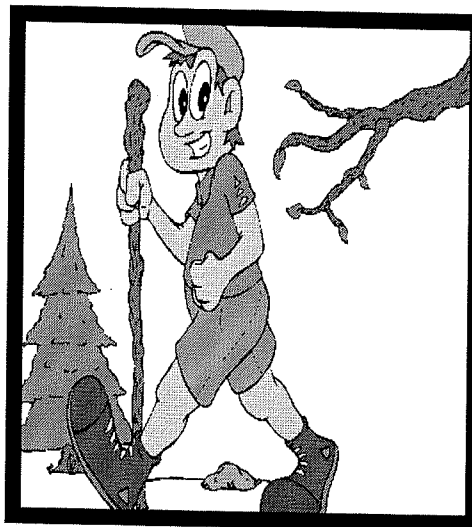
### Bike Rides

Every Monday following coffee & donuts there is an organized bike ride to a preset destination. See Don Wilcoxin @ MH 22 for further details.

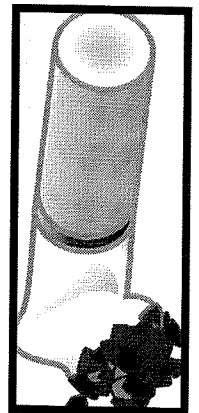


## Hiking

stand life and circumstances change with each and every one of us.

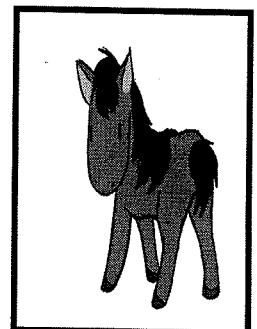

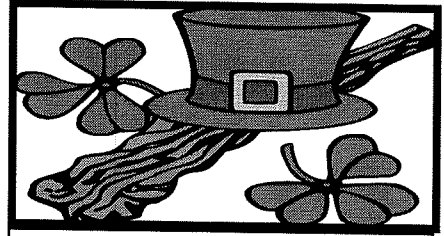

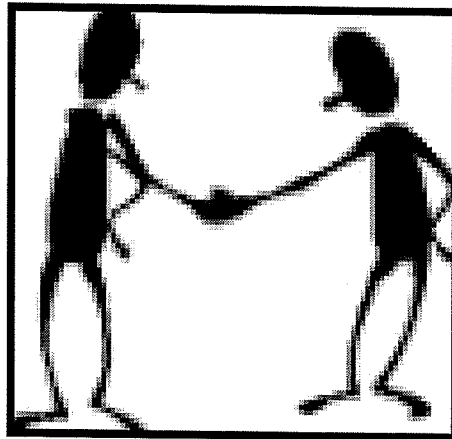


St Patrick's Day is right around the corner. Watch for details regarding our corn beef and cabbage dinner made with love by Pat Young.

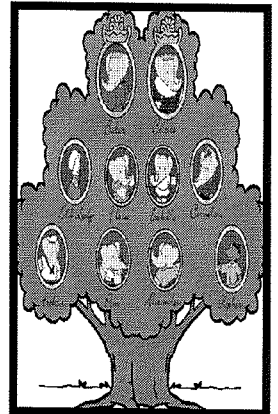
## Meet and Greet

Keep your eyes open for the sign letting you know where next week's location will be.



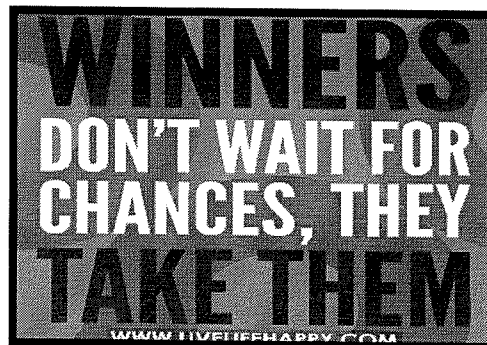
