For your Information:

- Bag ALL yard debris for pick up. The only exceptions are branches and palm fronds
- The large dumpster to the far left is for RECYCLABLES. Please break down all cardboard and absolutely no glass.
- All dogs must be on a leash and are NOT allowed in any buildings. ALWAYS pick up your pets waste.
- You may drop your propane tank off for refill. Please be sure your name is on your tank.

What We Talk About at Coffee & Donuts In Case You're Not There

- **Speeding:** Everyone needs to obey the speed limit of **9.5mph**. Most cars need no acceleration to achieve this speed. It may even require you to brake more often to stay under the limit.
- **Pets:** Be a responsible pet owner and always clean up after your pets. Keep your pets out off of other people's sites. This includes extendable leashes. **DO NOT** allow your pet to go more than a foot or two off the road to do their business. Also, **DO NOT** tether your dogs outside unattended.
- **Yard Debris:** We appreciate everyone who takes pride in keeping their sites raked and tidy. However, please bag all leaves and pine straw, we provide the bags in the office. Any branches and palm fronds may be stacked in a neat pile by the street for pick up.
- **Smoking:** Do not litter. Refrain from throwing cigarette butts anywhere other than the proper receptacles. Only smoke in designated areas if you are not on your site.
- **Recycle:** Break down all cardboard for the recycle dumpster. Absolutely no glass.
- **Mail:** UPS/FedEx ground are normally here around noon. FedEx Express is around 3pm. US Mail and packages come mid afternoon. Please give us time to sort and place in your mail slots. The red, white, and blue mail flag will fly in front of the office when it has been completed.
- **Activities:** All are welcome. If you would like to volunteer, please let us know.
- **Maintenance Requests:** Any work you would like to do or have done to your individual sites must be put on a maintenance request form and approved. Forms are available in the office.
- **Come to Coffee and donuts it's free:** You can grab a cup of coffee, enjoy a donut and meet your neighbors. Also a nice way to keep up with the activities happening.
